# Aligning The Ba Gua

### 1/2 AND 1/3 RULE

- If projection is wider than  $\frac{1}{2}$  the total building width it creates a missing area.
- If projection is less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  the total building width it creates an enhanced area.
- With two projections, use the 1/3 rule. If projections are wider than  $\frac{1}{3}$  the total building width, then they create missing area/s. If less than  $\frac{1}{3}$ , they create enhancements.
