














## 1/2 AND 1/3 RULE


- If projection is wider than ½ the total building width it creates a missing area.
- If projection is less than ½ the total building width it creates an enhanced area.
- With two projections, use the 1/3 rule. If projections are wider than 1/3 the total building width, then they create missing area/s. If less than 1/3, they create enhancements.



























## **BA GUA SOLUTIONS**
